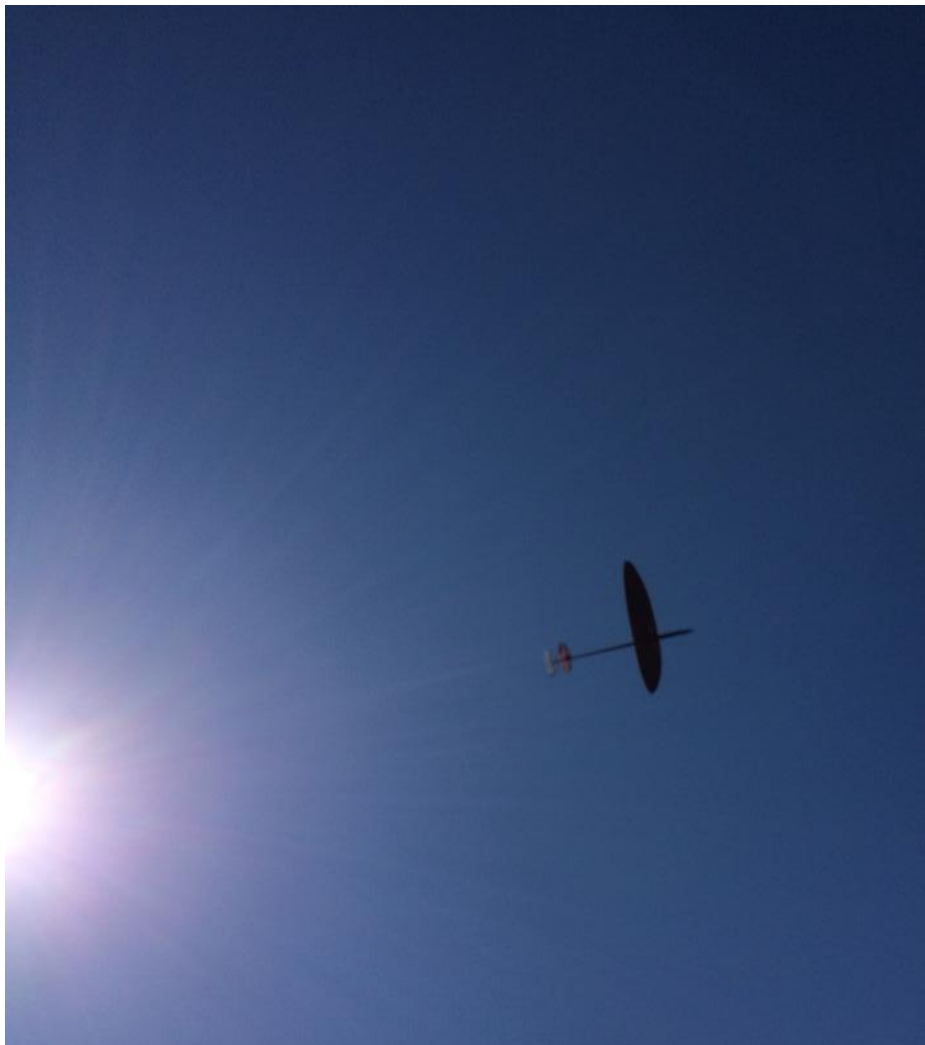
September DLG Contest Recap from John McNeil

Packing for the Land Down Under

Every year, our friend Steve Wenban over in Australia (ya' know, where "women glow and men plunder") organizes a 10-day Slope Fest with the Sydney Slope Soarers and Fly Manilla at Mount Borah near Manilla, New South Wales, Australia, about 285 miles north of Sidney. Mt. Borah is a world renown paragliding, hang gliding, ultralight and sailplane venue. Participants stay at a cabin camp owned by Godfrey Wenness (who also owns Mt. Borah) and for several years held the paragliding World Distance record with a flight of 335 km. I had the pleasure of watching, photographing (and heckling) three of the four "Yanks" (Matin Taraz, Jim "Pismo" Scott and Greg "howsthewind" Houck who flew over for the Fest this year. Basic Concept...Get 3 SUVs-worth of planes transportable to Australia.



Obviously...wings and horizontal stabs must be removable. Remember to use lots of foam. You can never have enough.



Don't forget to protect all the "sticky-out parts. Did I mention foam? You need lots of foam.



You'll need one person to sit around and contribute nothing to the process. Note the foam covered wing in the foreground. Nice zebra stripes ;-)



Then you'll want a hard shell case (golf, sport tube, whatever). Finally, of course, more FOAM!!! Then...it's off to Australia!!!! Check the thread for more about this excellent adventure.

Photo of the Month Contest

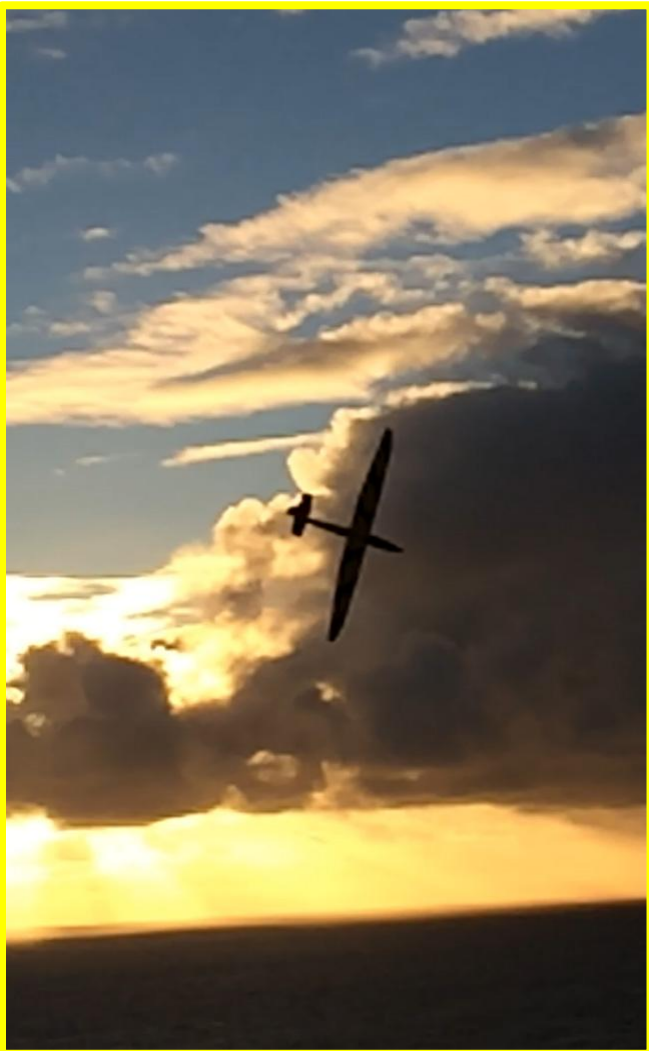

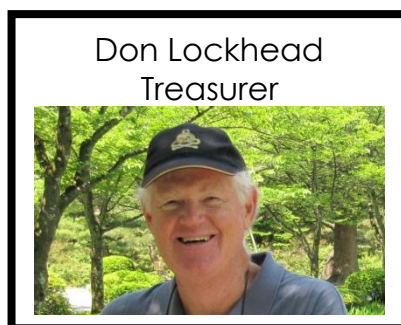
