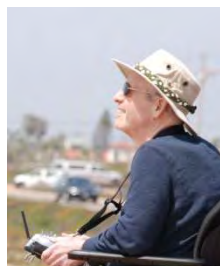

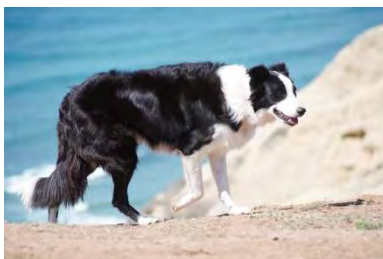

League of Silent Flight

A handful of Slopers will be working on LSF 1 (League of Silent Flight <http://www.silentflight.org>) in October once our paperwork arrives. I'll post on the Yahoo Groups, the Facebook page and on RCgroups when we'll make the attempt. The plan is to fly Poway in the morning, get the 5 minute thermal and the 5 spot landing requirements complete; then head down to Torrey and fly the 15 minute slope requirement. Being slopers, the Thermal task will be difficult but the most challenging will be the spot landings with the additional requirement of landing right-side-up and in one piece!!!

I just found out that the LSF 1 Voucher is tailored to the applicant. So, if you are interested in joining, please send in for a LSF Voucher, the cost is \$2 and the application and address is on the LSF Website.

Safety reminder:

Cliff rescues occur 3-4 times per year at Torrey. The Gliderport is frequently used as a landing zone for the Rescue Helicopter. Obviously we need to land our gliders to make room for the Heli. If you hear or see an ambulance or fire trucks at Torrey, be prepared for the Flight Director to ask all Gliders (RC, PG and HG) to clear the air for the rescue helicopter.

Important Poway Field Notice – Don Lockhead

On September 1st, the Poway City Council passed a new ordinance, on an urgency basis, that bans the “*Launching, Operation and Landing*” of Drones within specific zones in Poway (our field is in one of the listed zones).

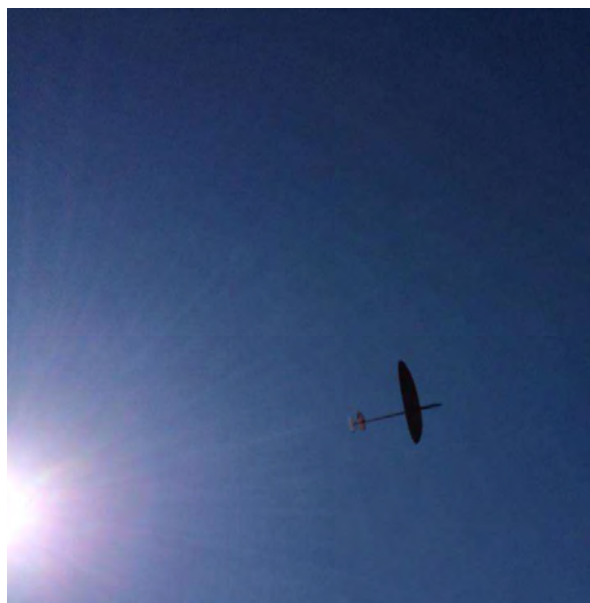
For the purpose of the ordinance a “*Drone is defined as an unmanned aerial vehicle, also known as remotely piloted aerial systems, used for either recreational or commercial purposes, which is capable of carrying a payload, including cameras for still pictures, video recording, or video streaming purposes, and is a fully-automated, powered, flying vehicle, in communication with the operator by way of external control, remote, systems.*”

The stated purpose for this ordinance and its urgency status was to respond to the concern that “Drones” could potentially interfere with fire-fighting within Poway.

The Club has submitted a letter to the Poway Mayor, City Council and City Attorney stating that we are in full agreement that any actions of any kind that interfere with firefighting are unacceptable. The letter also pointed out that TPG has over 25 years of history of safe and responsible flying in Poway and that we hope that in the future the Council will craft an ordinance that protects the public safety without imposing restrictions on the vast majority of RC pilots who fly responsibly.

If you fly at the Poway field please continue to respect the existing rules that limit our guest privileges to gliders only, no form of powered flight is allowed.

We will provide updates on the ordinance as they become available.

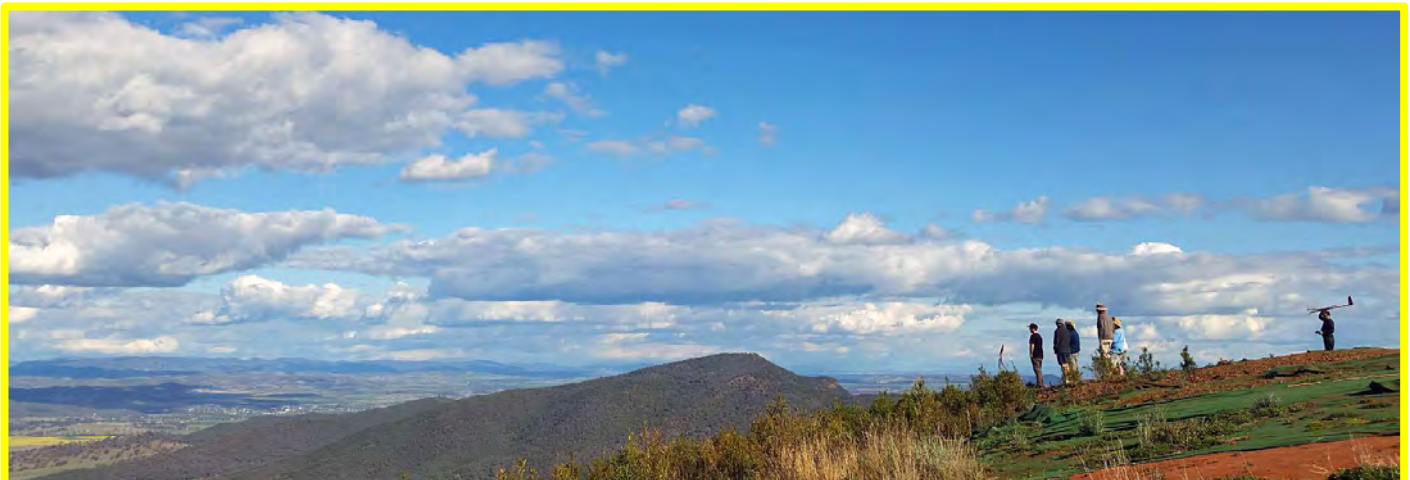
