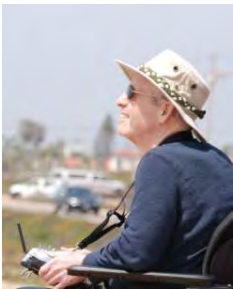

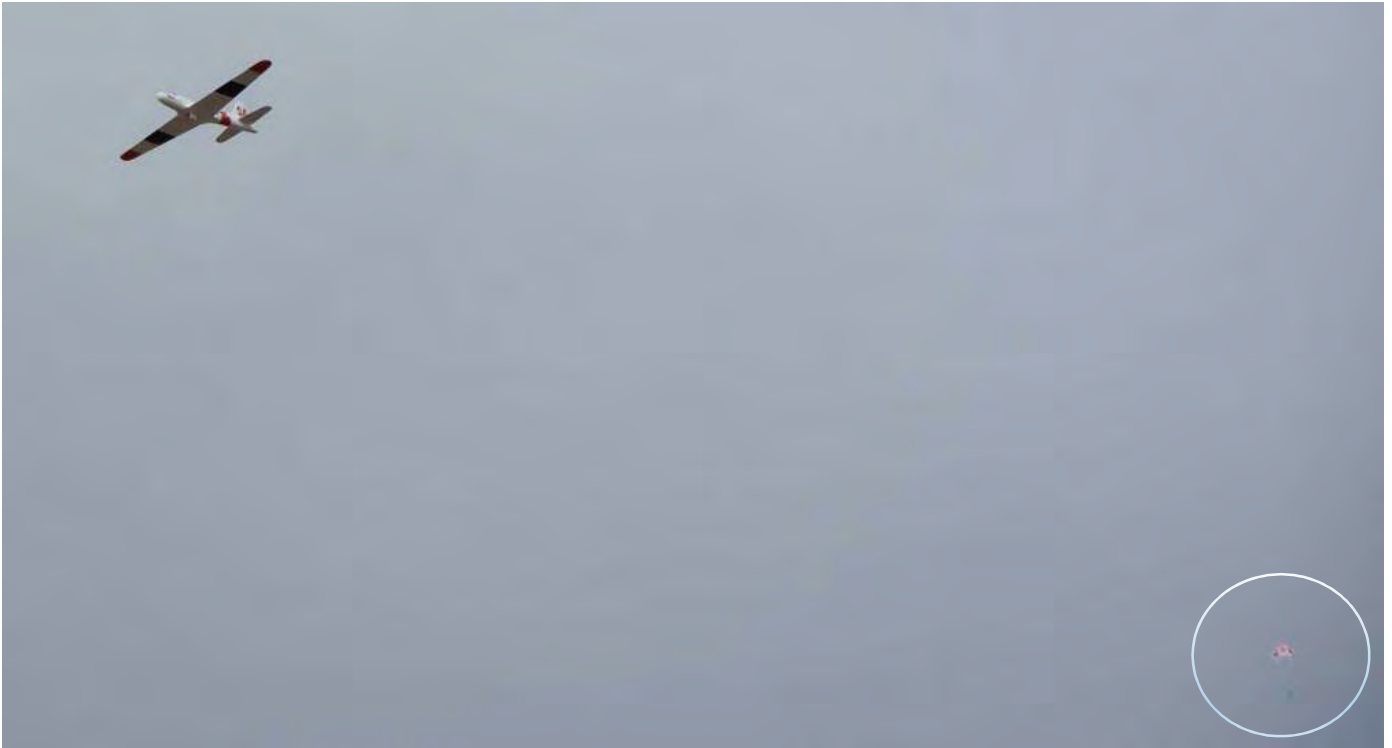

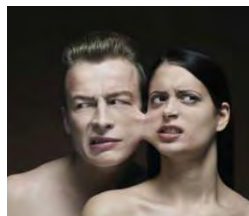

Now that we are almost at the deepest darkest depths of a typically brutal SoCal winter, some of us are busy building or repairing our models. Advances in Adhesives such as CA (Cyanoacrylate) have shortened the time to complete assemblies and repairs. Tasks that would have taken overnight to allow adhesives to cure or dry can now be completed in minutes.

Did you know that CA contains acid? Acid in CA is not dangerous, but CA fumes can be. Getting CA on certain parts of our body can be painful also. Luckily, Our Swedish friends published this informative paper on CA:

LSF (League of Silent Flight) Report, October 31, 2015 – Ray Pili

League of Silent Flight Attempt Day



For all the aspirants out there: Block out Saturday, December 12th for LSF Attempt Day starting out at Poway with a pilots meeting at 8:30 AM. We'll work on the Precision Spot Landing and the Thermal Duration tasks for LSF 1 and 2. From our last attempt on Halloween, day we learned the following:

1. Bring multiple planes. We lost two planes; one on a Hi-Start and another on a winch.
2. The landing task is best done with a DLG.
3. Thermals are hard to find.

We'll head over to Torrey around noon and check off our slope tasks.

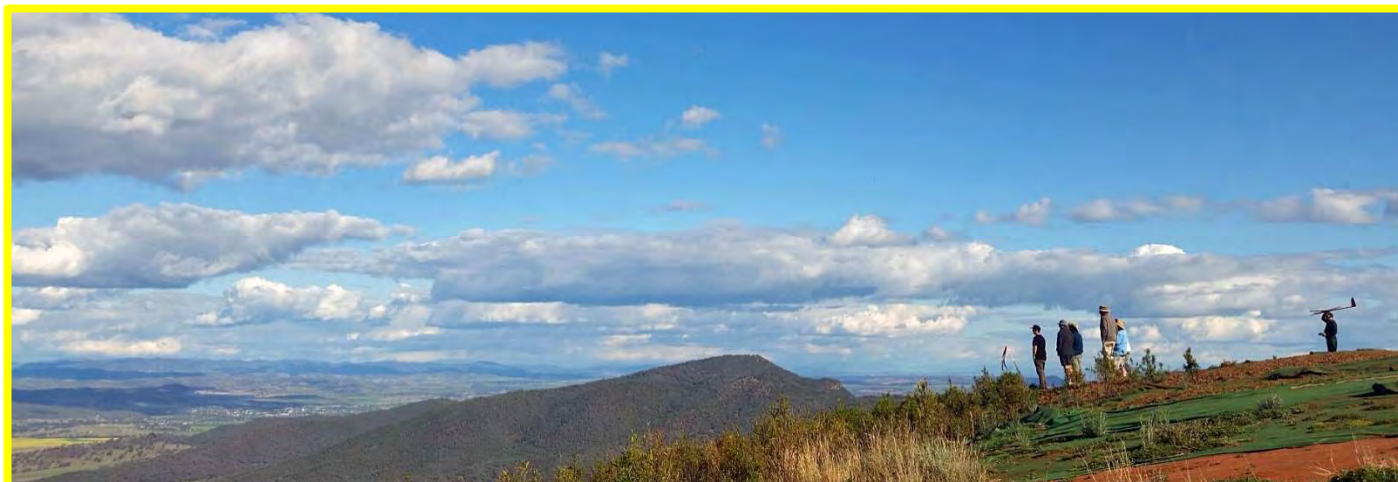
