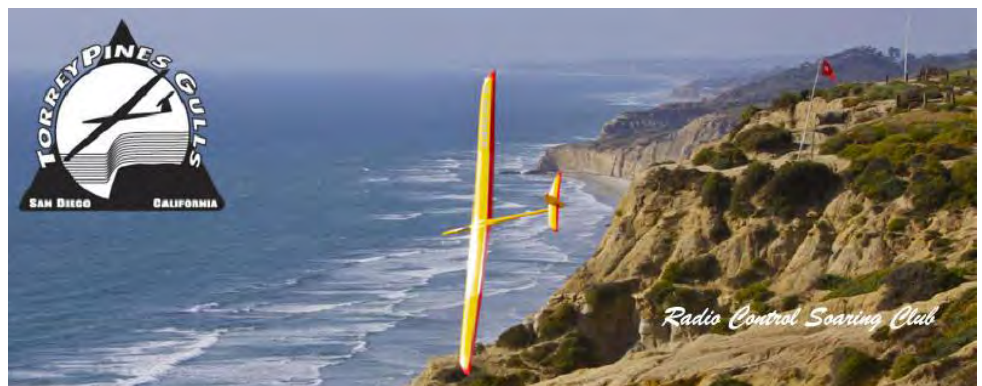

HOW TO TRIM PERFECT SERVO COVERS FOR YOUR MOLDED PLANES, by Dan Cummins, January 29, 2014

Today's molded planes tend to come with un-trimmed covers that need to be fit to the wing servo recesses (Fig 1). You can measure and trim with a ruler, but it seems they never come out quite perfect. Well, there is a failsafe and easy process you can follow so that your next set of servo covers fit perfectly:

1. Mark the servo arm high point on each side of the servo opening and arm/pushrod drive centerline. (Fig 2)
2. Using masking tape, tape off outside edge of servo recess ensuring that your piece(s) of tape are longer than your rough cut servo cover. (Fig 3)

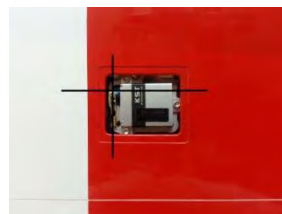

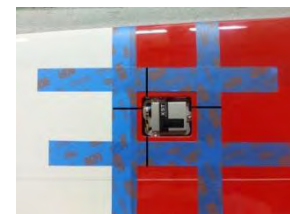

3. Mark servo cover bump spanwise and fore/aft center using a fine tip sharpie, and locate your rough trimmed servo cover onto the opening ensuring that you line up the marked centers on the cover with the marked centers on the tape installed on wing. (Fig 4)

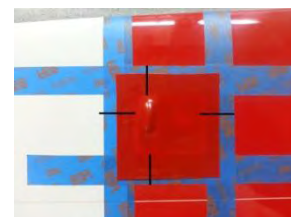

4. Using the (blue) tape laid down on the wing as a guide, tape down the servo cover such that the cover tape edge lines up with the wing tape edge. Do this for all four edges of the servo cover opening.

5. Carefully peel the tape & cover from the wing ensuring that the cover tape stays in place. **The edge of the cover tape now accurately marks the location of the edge of the wing servo recess perfectly!** (Fig 5)

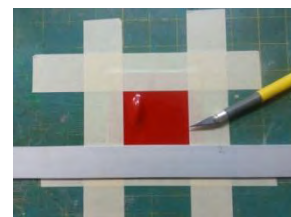

6. Now you are ready to trim your servo cover to size. Using a straight edge and a **NEW** Xacto blade, trim the cover by making multiple passes along the edge the tape.....use only moderate pressure when cuttinglet the blade do most of the work. Even thick covers will be cut though in 3 or 4 passes. (Fig 5)
7. After all four edges have been trimmed, you will want to smooth the edges with a high quality 220 grit sanding block. (continued next page)

8. Check the longitudinal fit and spanwise fit as you smooth/sand the edges to ensure that you don't over trim the cover. (Fig 6)
9. When the cover fits well in both directions, you may need to round each corner to get to a flush final fit. (Fig 7)
