Reminders on Rules Bill Eckles, Ed.

This is a reminder to heed all the rules for all three of our flying sites

Specifically flying at the Torrey Pines Glider Port remains busy and filled with opportunities to have a painful mishap. Therefore, be sure to obey the "blue sky" rule, keeping some visible space between your plane and another aircraft using the air space. Depth perception is difficult to calculate and fails many of us "mature" fliers, so keeping some sky between objects assures safe passage. Also, use of a spotter is more than desirable. If full-scale planes are flying, use of a spotter is mandatory. Similarly, during busy times a spotter is considered necessary. Be sure to get your club card or annual pass labeled with your flying skill level by a certified club member.

At Encinitas, please be sure to let the grass dry out after a rain...five days is the required span following a 1/4" shower there. Do NOT drive on the grass...park in the parking area or on the roadside. Use the new frequency board...it looks great and works wonders!

At Poway, please avoid any possibility of spooking horses and riders. While we have lots of room to fly, riders may be roaming into areas we would like to fly. So, give them the right-of-way and keep from above them if at all possible.
