February brought weather to mess up the traffic, but TPG members showed up in strong numbers for the General Meeting which featured Mike Mayberry telling us about the new Aurora 9, HiTec's new 2.4 GHz transmitter. Mike stressed the ease of programming that his radio offered, and added quite a few mechanical and ergonomic fetures that should make this competitively priced radio a big hit. Mike explained that HiTec was offering a price significantly below the "high end" competition and state of the art features because they were noticeably late entering the competitive markietplace. All told, it was a good presentation, if a bit lengthy, that was well received by a turnout of about 25 TPG members.

Last month, Jason Lilly demonstrated his passion for Dynamic Soaring with a big, green ThunderMaster ship capable of flyiing in the neighborhood of 350 mph. He stressed the strength of the model resulting from careful engineering of the composit materials involved in its construction. He is "overbuilding" his ships while paying strict attention to flight and aerodynamic consequences. At the speed these planes perform, there is no room for mistakes or failed parts..."explodes" understates the effect of impact between a solid object and a 300+ mph DS plane.

Last month we gave you the bad news that flying powered aircraft at Encinitas was interrupted until we could get formal permission from the property owners of the landfill. While we continue with our abatement, the ball is rolling and we hope to reinstate limited power fying in the near future. A task force has been formed with Cliff Hunter at the helm, supported by Keith Finkenbiner and Tom Minegar, and a request to allow powered flight has been submitted to the county. Still no promises, but the committee is optimistic that we will be able to fit in with the neighborhood given the positive results of the extensive testing that has been conducted.

The goal is to not exceed 50 db at the perimeter of the flying site with any of our aircraft. So far, performance is within this level if the size and power of the aircraft are controlled. One little twist is that the afternoon sea breeze wafts sound as well as fresh air to the neighborhood, so test levels can vary noticeably. The committee is working to control all elements of the situation to both allow successful flying and avoid disrupting the local residents. Thanks for all the good work, gentlemen!
