Unusual rain, up to inches in some areas caused a change in location for the October 24, SC2 contest. The contest was relocated to our Poway field for the expected large turnout that we get. 53 pilots registered for the contest, largest of the year, to fly four rounds of precision thermal duration.

The contest started promptly at 9 am with a seven minute task. Using two winches with

retrievers allowed a flight every minute from each winch. After three rounds the winches were so hot that the insulation was melting on the wires and a decision was made to limit the contest to three rounds.

Mike Lee from TSS was the big winner with a score of 2975 out of 3000 possible points. Our own Mike Smith was second with 2971.4. Third place went to Ali Khani of SULA with 2969. All scores will be posted on our web site shortly.

Our increased dues generated somewhat more money, but, unfortunately, we needed to spend much of it restoring Poway and improving the winches, retrievers and machinery at Encinitas.
