Next Sunday, August 11th, we will be flying at the Encinitas Flight center (if you need directions click the link below) for the August Thermal contest

We will be flying an pseudo F3J style contest to prepare for the upcoming US F3J team selections in Chicago. the Encinitas field and TPG rules; http://www.torreypinesgulls.org/encinitas.htm

The Tasks:

4 rounds....no launch past 11:45am, to be clear, it is your responsibility to launch by this time, or before (barring any MAJOR winch downtime)

first three rounds will be 10 minute duration 900/100, round four will be a 15 minute duration flight 900/100 There will be a 15 point per second penalty for going over your target time....but you still get the landing :-)

All landings will be on FAI landing tapes (please bring an FAI landing tape if you have one unless we do not have at least 4 FAI tapes, then we will use AMA tapes.

Pilots meeting at 8:55 am or so, first launch at 9:00am

Open flight window, NO retriever's and fully charged winch batteries

Please pass this on to all of the LA OC and IE guys you know, the more the Merrier

DLG Contest Report – August 17, 2013 – by Gary Fogel

It has been a while since the TPG had a monthly or bimonthly contest for DLGs. John McNeil and I had been contemplating the idea of reviving these in advance of the IHLGF 2014 event – so when I became aware of AMA's program to have "National Model Aviation Day" on August 17, it was a no-brainer to put the two together and help not only raise awareness for DLG but also for model airplanes and raise money for the Wounded Warriors Project. Unfortunately there wasn't much time for advertising but John assisted with this on RC Groups. The concept of this contest series is to have new DLG pilots learn F3K in a fun and low-key contest environment. Nine participants showed up at the Poway Flight Center to give it a go.

Five rounds of tasks were arranged:

- 1) Ladder (F3K task H): 30 s; 45 s; 60 s;75 s; 90 s; 105 s; 120 s
- 2) 5x 2min (F3K task M): Unlimited throws, best 5 flight, 2 min max
- 3) All up last down (F3K task E): 3x 3min 3 throws
- 4) 1, 2, 3, 4min (F3K task P): unlimited throws, any order
- 5) Next to last and last, 4 min max (F3K task C)

Pilots were grouped into Sportsman (Group A), Expert (Group B), so that experts could time for sportsmen and vice versa to add to the learning. Conditions were quite interesting as there were times when the lift was abundant and also times when lift was very difficult to find, even within one round. "Light and bubbly" was the best way to describe it. Another way would be H-O-T.

Congratulations to all who turned out – especially to Frank Campbell for his excellent flying (We'll have to rethink binning him in Group a next time!) Also to Mike Seid to manage somehow to fly his DLG back to the landing field upside down with no elevator at all after a midair with Amardeep. (Mike must have a secret supply of magic dust.) **We are looking forward to having another one of these on October 12 at the Poway Flight Center.** Come on out and join the fun! Specifically if you have never flown in a DLG contest or want to work on your skills, this is the low-key event for you. Experts are welcome and encouraged to attend but please help with advice and tips to new DLG pilots.


