The 14 story building which is part of the \$122 million housing project will render Torrey Pines useless for full scale gliders because it intrudes on the landing path. The pilots and the historians have urged UCSD to move the building but the university has refused. In recent months the Soaring Council has written letters to try and persuade UCSD officials to delay the housing project along with Bob Filner and several historic preservation groups. At the heart of the complaints is the way the university handled the approval process. We still need everyone's help and if you can all write letters it will be of great help. Other discussions have been about the Hawks, a new Hang glider club, wanting to have a seat on the Soaring Council. We will have further discussion on this at the next Council meeting. Remember everyone is welcome to attend the Soaring Council meetings.
